

WORKSHOP ON PYTHON PROGRAMMING: JUNE 22, 2019

Online large-scale teacher training program in Python Computer language for educational faculty of schools and colleges was organized on 22nd June, 2019 by the Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) at IIT-Bombay, funded by the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNTT), MHRD, Govt. of India. It was organized at various remote centers across the country.

The workshop was worthwhile as python has been introduced in the syllabus of 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th classes. Four teachers from Computer Department, Mr. Sanjay Ojha, Mrs. Usharani Deshraj, Mrs. Monika Mishra and Mr. R. N. Patel have been registered and attended the training program.

The entire training was by means of spoken videos tutorials on various topics of python language with examples and simultaneously teachers were allowed to practice exercises on those topics online.

Attended teachers have been permanently registered in these spoken tutorial website and they can take guidance of those tutorials even after the training, at any time in future also.

In that website, around 1100 other spoken tutorial videos on various topics related to computer subject are also present, which becomes an in hand library for a teacher.

During the workshop there were two online interactive questions - answer sessions were conducted at remote centers through the video conferencing software A-VIEW for clearing the doubts of teachers.

On request of many CBSE teachers they are also going to conduct a python training session exclusively for CBSE class XI & XII teachers according to the syllabus of CS and IP streams.

The workshop was fruitful and around 20 teachers participated at that centre. There were 7 more centers at Indore where the same workshop was conducted simultaneously.
